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CASE STUDY - CENTER FOR DIGESTIVE HEALTH

The Center for Digestive Health in Orlando is one of the region's top medical establishments. They specialize in the testing and treatment of digestive illnesses, and features anesthesiology,



pathology, and clinical services. CDH also has an on-site infusion suite that includes a full endoscopic research facility. With its role as one of the top digestive health centers in Florida, CDH must leverage its technology to better care for its patients.
